PROGRAM INFORMATION

- The priority deadline for applying for the program is May 1st.
- To apply, a student must enroll in the Education Transfer program.
- Students must enroll at Horry-Georgetown Technical College in the fall semester.
- Student participates are largely selected from under-served, socioeconomically disadvantaged and educationally atrisk communities.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Apply to and be accepted at Horry-Georgetown Technical College. You can apply online here.
- 2. Submit the application materials to Call Me MISTER, HGTC, P. O. Box 261966, Conway, SC 29528-6066;
 - Completed Call Me MISTER Program application.
 - Two letters of recommendation: one letter from an educator or administrator representing the last school attended and one letter from a person of the student's choice who can describe the student's involvement in the community and/or potential for entering the teaching profession.
 - An essay entitled "Why I Want To Teach" which will address the student's motivation for entering the teaching profession and the contributions he hopes to make to the profession and to the community as a teacher.
 - An essay entitled "Why I Should Be Accepted Into the Call Me MISTER Program".
 - A signed statement from a counselor or school official certifying that the student is from an under-served, under-privileged or economically disadvantaged background or area.
 - Most recent official transcript.
