

Per the South Carolina Labor and Licencensing Board-Nursing, a pre-licensure Nursing program may utilize up to 50% of their clinical hours in simulation format. Debriefing must be included.

Description of market research Agency performed to determine the availability of products or services that would meet the Agency's needs: Both Laerdal and Guamard offer pediatric simulators. However, the Gaumard simulator is more advanced, in that is allows both in-depth physical and cognitive assessment during the simulation. The Guamard Pediatric Hal simulator will provide a more realistic environment for the simulation experience, providing HGTC students with the necessary acute-care pediatric experience.

Description of supplies, construction, information technology, and/or services Vendor will provide under the contract: The vendor will provide the simulator, monitors, installation, training, and any other items deemed necessary for functionality of the simulator.

Detailed explanation why no other vendor's supplies, construction, information technology, and/or services will meet the needs of the Agency: HGTC Nursing department does currently utilize Laerdal simulators in the medical/surgical area. However, in the Maternity/Pediatric area, Guarmard is utilized. By purchasing the Guarmard Advanced Pediatric Hal simulator, there will be consistency and continuity among the current equipment utilized for this content area.
