Multiple Measures Placement Criteria Below:

Multiple measure scores will be valid for 3 years from the date of entry into SOATEST.

Multiple Measures Math	Math will be reviewed with a High School Transcript* reflecting a ALG 1, ALG 2 and Geo = B (80) Average then MM2. (MM2 courses will include MAT 110, MAT 120, MAT 122, MAT 175, MAT 250, MAT 251, depending upon program requirements.)
Multiple Measures English	English will be reviewed with a High School Transcript* reflecting an ENG 1 - 3 = B (80) Average then MM1. (MM1 courses will include ENG 101 or ENG 155 depending upon program requirements) OR students with ENG 1 and 2 with a (90) average.
GED College Ready	Guidelines effective March 2017: Score of 165 or higher on the Reasoning through Language Arts section will be coded as MM1. Score of 165 or higher on the Mathematical Reasoning section will be coded as MM2. Students will be registered for college-ready courses based on program of study.
Multiple Measures 4	Students with a High School Transcript greater than 3 years since graduation will be coded as MM4. (MM4 courses may include English 155/011 Lab or Writing Diagnostic to confirm placement, MAT 155, or entry level courses in programs <u>with permission from the program's Chair.</u>) Applicants who test below the WS5L level will be referred to adult ed. <i>Diagnostics will be scored as follows: WS1 = ENG 101 WS1L = ENG 101 w/ lab WS5 = ENG 155 WS5L = ENG 155 w/ lab</i>

*High school transcripts will be reviewed for MM1 and MM2 placement if graduation date is less than 3 years.
