

## EXPANDED DUTY DENTAL ASSISTING, CERTIFICATE

Graduates of HGTC's Expanded Duty Dental Assisting program are eligible to sit for the Dental Assisting National Board examination. Individuals who pass all parts of this examination are eligible for certification in South Carolina. This examination is recognized by all 50 states, however, some states may have additional non-academic requirements to register as a dental assistant in a particular state.
